Sealed bids will be received until 2:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 18, 2013, and then publicly opened and read by the University of Central Missouri, at the Procurement Office Conference Room, General Services Buildings, 102 W. South Street, Warrensburg, MO 64093, for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment and performing all work necessary to: Runway 18/36, Runway 13/31, Associated Taxiways and Apron Crack Repair and Seal Coat.

A complete set of Specifications and Contract Documents can be downloaded from the University of Central Missouri's bid site (<http://www.ucmo.edu/procurement/invite.cfm>), beginning on May 31, 2013. In order to submit a responsive bid as a Prime Contractor and to receive all necessary addendum(s) for this project, you must be on the Planholder's List. By filling out and submitting this form, you agree to be publicly listed on the bid site with your contact information as a planholder for all projects requested. A prebid conference will be held on Tuesday, June 11, 2013, at the Procurement Office Conference Room, General Services Buildings, 102 W. South Street, Warrensburg, MO 64093, at 10:00 a.m.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid guaranty in the amount of five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid. The bid guaranty may be by bid bond made payable to University of Central Missouri.

Bids may be held by University of Central Missouri for a period not to exceed 90 calendar days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

The right is reserved, as University of Central Missouri may require, to reject any bid and also the right to reject all bids.

Construction for this project will take place during the Summer 2013.

In accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, and the Missouri Prevailing Wage Law, the Contractor will be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the United States Department of Labor and the Missouri Division of Labor Standards, respectively. The highest rate between the two (Federal and State) for each job classification shall be considered the prevailing wage.

This project is subject to the requirements of 49 CFR Part 26 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Participation. The owner has established a contract goal of **8 percent** participation for small business concerns owned and controlled by qualified disadvantaged business enterprises (DBE). The bidder shall make and document good faith efforts, as defined in Appendix A of 49 CFR Part 26, to meet the established goal.
