Sealed bids for the construction of the Safe Route To Schools Sidewalk Enhancement, SRT-INF-H285 (110) for the City of Clarksburg will be received at: the office of MECO Engineering Co., Inc., 2701 Industrial Drive, Jefferson City, MO 65109 until 1:30 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 19th day of March 2013, at the office of MECO Engineering Co., Inc. , and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of a sealed envelope labeled as City of Clarksburg Safe Route to School Sidewalk Enhancement.

The proposed work includes: Construction of 1,248 Linear Feet of sidewalk along Highway H to the City of Clarksburg School.

Plans and specifications may be purchased from MECO Engineering Co., Inc., 2701 Industrial Drive, Jefferson City, MO 65109. The cost of Plans and Specifications is \$100. This is non-refundable.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Clarksburg hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Clarksburg reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 0%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
