and endorsed "Proposal" for construction of Federal Aid Project No. STP-9900(817), "Ash Grove Sidewalk Enhancement & Beautification-Phase I" will be received by the City until 10:00 A.M. on February 27, 2013 at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Ash Grove, Missouri, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. A pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 A.M. on February 15, 2013 at City Hall, 100 West Main St., Ash Grove, Missouri 65604. Attendance of the pre-bid meeting is optional.

The proposed work includes:

Sidewalk construction for approximately 2,500 lineal feet on the North side of East Prairie Lane between Maple Street and Piper Road. The work will also include the installation of two welcome signs along Highway 160 that will require the use of large stone and will include lighting and landscaping. Also included are various locations of landscaping along Highway 160.

The wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in the bid proposal. When Federal wage rates are applicable and included, this contract is subject to the "Work Hours Act of 1962," (P.L. 87-581; 76 Stat. 357) and implementing regulations.

Missouri law, 292.675 RSMO, requires the awarded Contractor and its subcontractor(s) to provide a ten-hour occupational safety and health administration (OSHA) construction safety program (or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations as a qualified substitute) for their on-site employees (laborers, workmen, drivers, equipment operators, and craftsmen) who have not previously completed such a program and are directly engaged in actual construction of the improvement (or working at a nearby or adjacent facility used for construction of the improvement). The awarded Contractor and its subcontractor(s) shall require all such employees to complete this ten-hour program, pursuant to 292.675 RSMo, unless they hold documentation on their prior completion of said program. Penalties for non-compliance include Contractor forfeiture to The City of Ash Grove in the amount of \$2,500, plus \$100 per contractor and subcontractor employee for each calendar day such employee is employed beyond the elapsed time period for required program completion under 292.675 RSMo.

The City of Ash Grove hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.
