Prospective Bidders and others interested in the Work are highly encouraged to attend the pre-bid conference. The project's 9% DBE requirement will be discussed. Addenda will be issued, as the City considers necessary, in response to issues raised at the pre-bid conference, or submitted in writing.

All wages paid for work under this Contract shall comply with requirements of the prevailing wage law of the State of Missouri, Missouri Public Law 294, Sec. 290.210 through 290.340, R.S. Mo. 1969, as amended. The project is subject to the requirements of RSMo Sec. 292.675 concerning worker safety. Pursuant to

RSMo Sec 285.530 bidders are required to submit, or have on file with the City of Grandview, the Worker Eligibility Verification affidavit within the contract documents. The City of Grandview reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Prior to the award of this Contract, the Contractor and all sub-contractors may be required to furnish evidence of a written Affirmative Action Program to ensure that all employees are treated equally without regard to race, color, religion, sex, handicap or national origin, pursuant to Executive Order # 11246 and amendments thereto, and be fully registered with the Federal government's Central Contractor Registration website (www.ccr.gov).

The City of Grandview, Missouri, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially or economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for award.

Missouri Law, 292.675 RSMO, requires the awarded contractor and its subcontractors to provide a ten-hour Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) construction safety program (or similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations as a qualified substitute) for their on-site employees (laborers, workmen, drivers, equipment operators, and craftsmen) who have not previously completed such a program and are directly engaged in actual construction of the improvement (or working at a nearby or adjacent facility used for construction of the improvement). The awarded contractor and its subcontractor(s) shall require all such employees to complete this ten-hour program, pursuant to 292.675 RSMO, unless they hold documentation on their prior completion of said program. Penalties for non-compliance include contractor forfeiture to the City of Grandview, Missouri in the amount of \$2,500.00 plus \$100 per contractor and subcontractor employee for each calendar day such employee is employed beyond the elapsed time period for required program completion under 292.675 RSMO.

All Prime Contractors must be on MoDOT's approved contractor listing and must have a fully responsive contractor questionnaire on file with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date. The project will also have a DBE requirement of 9% and the DBE Sub-Contractors must be on the MRCC DBE Directory prior to bidding.
