This contract provides for, but is not limited to, the necessary grading, asphalt & concrete paving, culverts, storm sewer improvements, concrete curb and gutter, driveways, concrete sidewalks, sodding, signing, pavement marking, retaining walls, and all appurtenant work for the completion of the project. All Prime Contractors must be on MoDOT's Approved Contractor Listing 7 days before bid opening and the DBE Sub-Contractors must be on the MRCC DBE Directory prior to Bidding. The DBE goal on this project is 12%. **Two trainee slots of 1,000 hours each are also required for this project.** Each bidder shall take into consideration the number of days for completion of the project as specified in the Proposal. Payment for all work performed and materials furnished for construction by the Contractor shall be made in cash or check upon completion of the contract and acceptance of the work by the City.

Construction covered hereby will be subject to all requirements of the Prevailing Wage Law of the State of Missouri and to the wage rates determined by the Industrial Commission of Missouri and set forth in the Contract Documents.
