NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids, addressed to City of Lake Saint Louis, 200 Civic Center Drive, Lake Saint Louis Missouri, 63367 for the proposed work will be received until 12.00 Noon, (prevailing local time) on January 31, 2013, at City Hall, 200 Civic Center Drive, Lake Saint Louis, Missouri, 63367, and will be publicly opened and read at 2:00 p.m. or soon thereafter on the same day. Bids should be delivered to: Administration Office, City of Lake Saint Louis, 200 Civic Center Drive, Lake Saint Louis Missouri 63367.

(1) **PROPOSED WORK:** The proposed work, hereinafter called the work, includes:

concrete sidewalk, modular block retaining walls, pavers, curbing, storm sewer work, street lighting and miscellaneous work associated with sidewalk construction.

(2) **COMPLIANCE WITH CONTRACT PROVISIONS:** The bidder, having examined and being familiar with the local conditions affecting the work, and with the contract, contract documents, including the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission's "Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011," and "St. Louis County Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, Latest Edition", Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District Standard Construction Specifications for Sewers and drainage Facilities, Latest Edition, their revisions, and the request for bid, including appendices, the special provisions and plans, hereby proposes to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, services, etc., required for the performance and completion of the work. All references are to the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, as revised, unless otherwise noted.

(3) **PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE:** If the bid is accepted, the bidder agrees that work shall be diligently prosecuted at such rate and in such manner as, in the judgment of the engineer, is necessary for the completion of the work within the time specified as follows in accordance with Sec 108:

Calendar Days: 120

A Calendar day shall be any day starting from the effective date of the Notice to Proceed and including all Saturdays, Sundays, holidays and nonwork days.

(4) **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:** The bidder agrees that, should the bidder fail to complete the work in the time specified or such additional time as may be allowed by the engineer under the contract, the amount of liquidated damages to be recovered in accordance with Sec 108 shall be as follows: Liquidated damages per day \$ 700.00
