

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids addressed to Mayor Don Scowden, City of Greenville, will be received at 108 Walnut Street, Greenville, Missouri 63944 until 11:00 A.M. (Local Time) on November 29, 2012, and then publicly opened and read for furnishing all labor, material, equipment, and performing all work required to construct the Greenville Recreational Trail.

The project consists of installation of 8-foot wide walking trail and parking area – see details below.

Proposals shall be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check upon a national or state bank in an amount not less than five (5%) percent of the total maximum bid price payable without recourse to the CITY OF GREENVILLE or a bid bond in the same amount from a reliable surety company, as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a contract and execute performance and payment bonds within ten (10) days after notice of award of Contract to him. The notice of award of Contract shall be given by the Owner within ninety (90) days following the opening of bids.

The successful Bidder must furnish a performance and payment bond upon the form provided in the amount of one hundred (100%) percent of the contract price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Missouri to act as surety, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner.

The attention of bidders is called to the fact that a contractor must be registered with the Corporation Division of the Missouri Secretary of State's office to conduct business in the State of Missouri. The Bidder shall comply with requirements of this Missouri law.

Plans, specifications, proposal forms and other contract documents may be examined at City Hall, 108 Walnut Street, Greenville, Missouri 63944 and at the office of the Engineer, Civil Engineering Associates, LLC.
