Bidders shall be qualified to do business and licensed in accordance with all applicable laws of the state and local governments where the Project is located. OWNER'S RIGHT TO REJECT

The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid and also the right to reject all bids. All bids may be rejected for, without limitation, the following reasons:

- 1. If in the opinion of the City the lowest bid or bids are excessive.
- 2. The advertised bidding or contract documents are inadequate, ambiguous or otherwise deficient in any respect.
- 3. The construction of all or any part of the project is no longer required.
- 4. The bidding and contract documents did not include all of the intended evaluation factors.
- 5. The bids were not independently arrived at in open competition.
- 6. There are indications that any of the bids were collusive or were submitted in bad faith.
- 7. The bids received did not provide sufficient competition to ensure adequate price.
