

## Invitation to Bid

Sealed bids for the Lewis and Clark Expressway, Sterling Avenue Breakout Improvements, Project DP-3400 (408), will be received at: City of Sugar Creek, 103 S. Sterling Ave, Sugar Creek, MO 64054 until 12:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November, at the office of the City Administrator, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in accordance with the Bidder Checklist.

The proposed work includes: Grading, drainage, paving, landscaping, street lighting, signing, pavement marking, traffic control, construction of a 9-11 memorial exhibit, trail lighting, retaining walls, entry monuments, and electrical and water service installation in the City of Sugar Creek, for a total length of approximately 940 feet.

Plans and specifications may be picked up from the office of the City Administrator at the City of Sugar Creek, 103 S. Sterling Ave, Sugar Creek, MO 64054.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 AM on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of November, at the Sugar Creek Police and Fire Station, 1001 Heroes Way, Sugar Creek, MO 64053. **All bidders are required to attend the pre-bid meeting.**

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Sugar Creek hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this invitation to bid, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Sugar Creek reserves the right to reject any or all bids that contain irregularities in the bid documents. Furthermore, this project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.

The DBE Goal for this project is 14%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
