Mexico Road Intersection Improvements - All work and materials to construct the Turn lane additions and traffic signal upgrades at two intersections: Mexico Road with Knaust Road / Belleau Creek and Mexico Road with Sonderen Road / White Oak.

State and Federal wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in the bid proposal. The higher rate shall apply for this project. When Federal wage rates are applicable and included, this contract is subject to the "Work Hours Act of 1962", (P.L. 87-581; 76 Stat. 357) and implementing regulations.
