and endorsed "Proposal" for constructing (or improving) Project STP-9900 (115), City of Lathrop, Missouri, will be received by the City Administrator until 11:00 o'clock A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 16th day of October, 2012, at the office of the City Administrator, City Hall, 707 Oak Street, Lathrop, Missouri and at that time will be publicly opened and read.

The proposed work includes:

### Phase I - Sidewalk & Lighting Enhancements

Construction of the following:

- Sidewalk with Curb and Ramp Improvements
- Business Entrance Step(s) / Landing Improvements
- Street Lighting Improvements

Pre-Bid Meeting: There will be a mandatory pre-bid meeting at 10:00 o'clock A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2012, at the office of the City Administrator, City Hall, 707 Oak Street, Lathrop, Missouri.

This is a prevailing wage project. The wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in the bid proposal. When Federal wage rates are applicable and included, this contract is subject to the "Work Hours Act of 1962," (P.L. 87-581: 76 Stat. 357) and implementing regulations. Certified payroll for each employee must be submitted and approved on a weekly basis.

The City of Lathrop hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award. The DBE participation goal for this project is 8%.

Enrollment in Federal Work Authorization Program – Bidders are informed that, pursuant to Section 285.530 RSMo., the successful bidder shall, by sworn affidavit and provision of documentation, affirm its enrollment and participation in a federal work authorization program with respect to the employees working in connection to the contracted services.

Safety Training Program – Bidders are informed that the project is subject to the requirements of Section 292.675 RSMo., pertaining to on-site employees completing a course in construction safety and health approved by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).

MoDOT Pre-Qualification Requirements - The Prime Contractor shall not be required to meet the MoDOT pre-qualification requirements for this project. "Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction will be waived for this project.
