Sealed proposals for the construction of two walk bridges and new sidewalks, will be received by the City of Piedmont at the City Hall located in Piedmont, Missouri, until 10:30 a.m. on October 5, 2012 and at that time will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The proposed project includes: The construction of two prefabricated pedestrian truss bridges (118' and 105'), removal and replacement of 400 lf of 5' wide sidewalk with curb and gutter, construction of 423 lf of new 5' wide sidewalk with curb and gutter, removal of 548 of 3' wide sidewalk, construction of 548 lf of new curb and gutter, and associated pavement marking and site appurtenances.
