An endorsed "Proposal" for the Edison Avenue Asphalt Overlay Project No. STP-5410(612) in St. Louis County will be received by the Office of the Director of Public Services, City Hall, 690 Chesterfield Pkwy W, Chesterfield, Missouri, 63017-0760 until 10:00 am (prevailing central time) on the 18th of September, 2012 and at that time will be publicly opened and read.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 am on the 11th day of September, at City Hall, 690 Chesterfield Parkway West, Chesterfield, Missouri, 63017. All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.

The project consists of a 2" asphalt mill and overlay (approximately 55,000 SY), restriping, traffic control, and other necessary appurtenances on Edison Avenue between Long Road and Baxter Road.

Bid packages will be available after 10:00 am on the 28th of August at City Hall. The packages may be reviewed at that location or may be purchased for a non-refundable fee of \$50.00 per set of plans, specifications and bidding documents. Single sheets of plans may be obtained for one dollar (\$1.00) per sheet.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

The City of Chesterfield hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The DBE Goal for this project is zero (0%).

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

Proposals must be on the forms provided in the bid documents. The right is reserved to reject any or all bids by the City with MoDOT concurrence.
