

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

and endorsed "Proposal" for Feise, Knaust and Belleau Creek Roads sidewalk improvements, City of O'Fallon, Missouri, will be received by the City of O'Fallon – Purchasing Agent, 100 North Main Street, until 10:00 a.m. on September 14, 2012, and at that time will be publicly opened and read in the Councilman Conference Room.

The proposed work includes:

All work and materials necessary to install the sidewalk improvements as shown on the plans. Work will include sidewalks, improvements to existing drainage features, installation of a bench, a message center and landscaping.

It is the intent of the City of O'Fallon to begin the project in calendar year 2012 and complete the project in calendar year 2012 with minimal "out of service" time.

State wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in the bid proposal.

The prime contractor must be on MoDOT's approved contractor listing. This requirement includes that the contractor has submitted to MoDOT a Contractor Questionnaire *and/or* Contractor Prequalification Questionnaire with attachments no later than seven (7) days prior to the date and hour of the bid opening (see Section 102.2 of the *Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction* for more details). The prime contractor must perform, with its own organization, work amounting to not less than 30% of the total original contract price.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

The City of O'Fallon hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award. **A DBE goal of 14%** has been established for this project. Only the work performed by DBE subcontractors that appear on MoDOT's approved listing at the time of bid opening will be applied towards calculating the DBE goal.

Plans and specifications will be available for purchase for \$50.00 on August 24, 2012 at the City of O'Fallon City Hall in the Community Development Office, 100 North Main Street (636-379-5492). Make all Checks payable to City of O'Fallon.

Proposals must be on forms provided.

The right is reserved to reject any or all bids by the City with MoDOT concurrence.

The contract will be awarded to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder.
