All Proposal Forms shall be submitted within a bound Project Manual. Proposal Forms detached from the Project Manual will be considered irregular and will be disqualified.

A prebid conference for this project will be held at **2:00pm on August 22nd, 2012 at El Dorado Springs Memorial Airport.**

Each proposal must be accompanied by a bid guaranty in the amount of five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid. The bid guaranty may be by certified check or bid bond made payable to **City of El Dorado Springs, Missouri.**

Bids may be held by the **City of El Dorado Springs, Missouri** for a period not to exceed **60 days** from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

The right is reserved, as the **City of El Dorado Springs, Missouri** may require, to reject any bid and also the right to reject all bids.

In accordance with the Missouri Prevailing Wage Law, the Contractor will be required to comply with the wage and labor requirements and to pay minimum wages in accordance with the schedule of wage rates established by the Missouri Division of Labor Standards.
