An endorsed "Proposal" for constructing improvements to front street in Labadie, Franklin County, Missouri, will be received by the County until 10:00 A.M. (prevailing local time) on Tuesday, August 14 2012, at the office of the Franklin County Clerk, 400 East Locust Street, Room 201, Union, MO 63084, and at that time will be publicly opened and read.

The proposed work includes:

All work and materials including grading and construction a street reconstruction project along Front Street in Labadie, MO. The total length of the improvements is approximately 500 feet. The scope of improvements includes decorative site furnishing and amenities; pavement construction; ornamental and native landscaping, signage and marking; permeable pavements; drainage improvements; hardscape plaza spaces; and other miscellaneous improvements defined in contract documents. The project is located in Franklin County along Route T near the intersection of Route T and Route MM.

It is the intent of Franklin County to have this project begun and completed in calendar year 2012.

State wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in the bid proposal.

The prime contractor must be on MODOT's approved contractor listing. This requirement includes that the contractor has submitted to MODOT a Contractor Questionnaire and/or Contractor Prequalification Questionnaire with attachments not later than seven (7) days prior to the date and hour of the bid opening (see Section 102.2 of the *Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction* for more details). The prime contractor must perform, with its own organization, work amount to not less than 30% of the total original contract price.

Franklin County hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantage individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award, **A DBE goal of 15%** has been established for this project. Only the work performed by DBE subcontractors that appear on MODOT's approved listing at the time of bid opening will be applied towards calculating the DBE goal.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project must provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

The character and amount of security to be furnished by bidders is stated in the contract documents mentioned above.
