Sealed bids will be received by the City Clerk located at 601 South Grand, Houston, Missouri 65483 until 1:30 p.m., on July 19, 2012 and then publicly opened and read aloud for construction of:

Approximately 2000 LF of sidewalk construction/reconstruction and 3,000 LF of bicycle lane painting/stripping and associated appurtenances.

Phone 573-364-6362 to arrange delivery upon payment of a non-refundable sum of \$100.00 for each complete set. An additional amount of \$30.00 will be charged for mailing of bidding documents.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at Houston City Hall at 1:30 pm July 10, 2012.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The Owner hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

The Owner waives Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition relative to the contractor questionnaire.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Houston reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
