Each bid must be accompanied by a cashier's check or satisfactory bid bond payable to the City of Warrenton, Missouri, in the amount of five percent (5%) of the amount of the total bid as a guarantee that the successful bidder will enter into a contract and furnish the required bonds within fifteen (15) days after the award is made.

All bids shall be made on the forms provided. The City of Warrenton hereby reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informalities in the bids received, and the right to reject non-responsive bids with MoDOT's concurrence.

The City of Warrenton hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Contractor shall pay not less than the prevailing hourly rates of wages, as determined by the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission of Missouri. The wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined and are set forth in these appendices. When Federal wage rates are applicable and included, this contract is subject to the "Work Hours Act of 1962", (P.L. 87-581:76 Stat. 357) and implementing regulations.

The contract DBE goal for the amount of work to be awarded is 8% of the total federal project price.
