

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the City Clerk located at 109 East Broadway, Ashland, Missouri 65010 until 1:30 p.m., on June 14, 2012 and then publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted on the bid form provided with the bidding documents. The proposed work includes:

Approximately 1,500 LF of city street reconstruction including associated concrete sidewalks, drives, curb and gutter, storm-water piping and appurtenances.

A complete set of the bidding documents are on file for examination at City Hall and at the office of the Engineers, CM Archer Group, 310 East 6th Street, Rolla, Missouri 65401. Phone 573-364-6362 to arrange viewing. Copies of the bidding documents may be obtained from the Engineer upon payment of a non-refundable sum of \$120.00 for each complete set. An additional amount of \$30.00 will be charged for mailing of bidding documents.

A Pre-bid Conference will be held at City Hall at 1:30 p.m. on June 4, 2012. Each bidder must submit a bid security in the amount of five percent (5%) of their total bid.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Ashland hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Ashland reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 5%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
