

## **Laclede Station Road Reconstruction**

### **Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for the **Laclede Station Road Reconstruction, STP-5401(638)** will be received by the Office of the Director of Public Works, City Hall, 7601 Manchester Avenue, Maplewood, Missouri until 10:00 a.m. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2012, and at that time will be publicly opened and read.

The proposed work includes the removal and reconstruction of approximately 1,150 feet of concrete street pavement, curbs, sidewalks, property restoration and other necessary appurtenances.

Bid packages will be available after 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 8, 2012. The bid packages may be reviewed at no cost on the internet at the electronic plan room of Drexel Technologies:

or may be purchased from Drexel Technologies for a non-refundable fee of \$40.00 per set of plans, specifications and bidding documents.

A prebid conference will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 22, 2012 at Maplewood City Hall. **All bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting.**

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Maplewood hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Maplewood reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 20%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
