Notice to Contractors

Sealed bids for Holden Safe Routes Pedestrian Sidewalk & Federal Project No. SRTS-INF-H104 (004), will be received at: 101 W. 3rd Street, Holden, MO 64040 until 1:00 o'clock P.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 4th day of May, at the office of the Holden City Hall, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted as hard-copy (paper) documentation.

The proposed work includes: Construction of new pedestrian sidewalk along Main Street from 16th Street to 19th Street and along Market Street from 9th Street to 19th Street, and along Eagle Drive from Main Street to Private Drive and along 9th, 12th, 16th, and 19th Streets in the City of Holden, Missouri.

Plans and specifications may be purchased from the office of Drexel Technologies at 10840 West 86th Street, Lenexa, KS 66214.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Holden hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The DBE Goal for this project is 6%.

No 2nd Tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
