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**RE: Addendum 1: Bid 12-117 – Jungermann Road, Phase III – Willott Road to McClay Road**

To all Contract Bidders of Record,

This Addendum, consisting of two (2) pages, is issued to modify, explain or correct the original Contract documents as noted below, and is hereby made a part of the Contract documents.

**Questions/Clarifications**

1. I see in the specs that the contractor may use the City's water to supply the diamond grinding operation. I understand there is a permit for that, but will the contractor be charged a usage fee for the water? If so can you tell me what the price per Mgal is?

*Contractor will not be charged a usage fee. I'm not sure what the permit states but the contractor is required to have back flow prevention and a meter when accessing the City's water supply.*

2. I am wondering if the city still has the construction debris disposal facility operated by Metro Development? I know when we bid the previous phase of this project they were willing to accept the diamond grinding slurry material and I would like to see if this is still an option. If so, what is their current fee for this. If not, does the city have any additional locations where a dump site could be set up for this material?

*Metro Development owns and operates that facility. The contractor will have to contact Metro regarding disposal of any waste material and affiliated costs. The City does not have locations where material can be disposed.*

**Deletion**

In Section L, Paragraph 18 of the contract states:

**DISPOSAL OF SPOIL AND EXCESS MATERIALS:** All spoil material generated by the project shall be disposed at a location approved by the City prior to removal from the project area. All costs associated with spoil material disposal shall be considered incidental to the work associated with this contract.

THE PARAGRAPH BELOW (in all bold) IS **DELETED** FROM THE CONTRACT:

**The City reserves the option to require all spoil material designated as clean fill material and to be stock piled at a site to be determined by the City. Said stock pile site will be no more than ten miles (10) from the project location.**

THESE TWO (2) PARAGRAPHS WILL REMAIN IN THE CONTRACT:

All pavement, curb and sidewalks removed shall be broken up in pieces that are generally recognized as one-man riprap, 18" square size or smaller.

Certain organic spoil material may be disposed at City of St. Peters Earth Center, located at 115 Ecology Drive for a fee. The Contractor can obtain information regarding the types of material accepted, hours of operations and disposal fees by calling 636-477-6600, extension 573.
