March 13, 2012, for the HEBER HUNT SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL project, Project 2011-05, FEDERAL PROJECT NO. SRTS-INF-H285(109), dated October 21, 2011, revised January 18, 2012 and will be publicly opened and read aloud in the second floor Conference Room of the Municipal Building. The project includes removal of existing sidewalk; unclassified excavation and backfill; replacement of select concrete approaches, driveways, and curb and gutter; installation of storm sewer piping; consolidation of subgrade; construction of ADA ramps and sidewalk; and all incidental and/or related work as necessary to provide a complete project.

This contract requires payment of the prevailing hourly rate of wages for each craft or type of work required to execute the contract as determined by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, and requires adherence to a schedule of minimum wages as determined by the United States Department of Labor. For work performed anywhere on this project, the contractor and the contractor's subcontractors shall pay the higher of these two applicable wage rates. The applicable state wage rates for this contract are detailed in "Annual Wage Order No. 18", that is in the Project Manual. The applicable federal wage rates for this contract are the effective Davis-Bacon federal wage rates posted the tenth day before the bid opening date and are attached herein. These supplemental bidding documents have important legal consequences. It shall be conclusively presumed that they are in the bidder's possession, and they have been reviewed and used by the bidder in the preparation of any bid submitted on this project.

The City of Sedalia hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction regarding prequalification and the Contractor Questionnaire has been waived for this project.

This project has a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal; the contract DBE goal for the amount of work to be awarded is 13% of the total federal project price.

Missouri Law, 292.675 RSMO, requires any awarded contractor and its subcontractor(s) to provide a ten-hour Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) Construction Safety Program (or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations as a qualified substitute) for their on-site employees (laborers, workmen, drivers, equipment operators, and craftsmen) who have not previously completed such a program and are directly engaged in actual construction of the improvement (or working at a nearby or adjacent facility used for construction of the improvement). The awarded contractor and its subcontractor(s) shall require all such employees to complete this ten-hour program, pursuant to 292.675 RSMO, unless they hold documentation on their prior completion of said program. Penalties, for Non-Compliance include contractor forfeiture to the Contracting Authority in the amount of \$2,500, plus \$100 per contractor and subcontractor employee for each calendar day such employee is employed beyond the elapsed time period for required program completion under 292.675 RSMO.
