Sealed bids will be received at the office of the Purchasing Agent, 320 East McCarty Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101, until **1:30 P.M., on Tuesday, March 13, 2012**. The bids will be opened and read aloud in the Council Chambers at **1:30 P.M.** on that same day.

The proposed work for the project entitled "**Project No. 32106, Missouri Boulevard Sidewalks**" will include the furnishing of all material, labor, and equipment to construct sidewalks of various widths along the southern side of the 1200 through 2100 blocks of Missouri Boulevard with approaches, ramps, pedestrian signals, retaining walls, guardrail, handrail, grading, and associated items.

A **pre-bid conference** will be held at **10:30 A.M., on Friday, March 2, 2012** in the **Boone / Bancroft Conference Room** of City Hall, 320 E, McCarty Street, Jefferson City, MO 65101. All prospective bidders are urged to attend.

Copies of the contract documents required for bidding purposes may be obtained from the Director of Public Works, 320 East McCarty Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. A non-refundable deposit of **Fifty-five Dollars (\$55.00)** will be required for each set of plans and specifications. Individual full size sheets of the plans may be obtained for Three Dollars (\$3.00) per sheet.

The City of Jefferson hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The contract will require compliance with the wage and labor requirements and the payment of minimum wages in accordance with the Schedule of Wage Rates established by the Missouri Division of Labor Standards or Davis-Bacon Federal Wage Rates, whichever is higher.
