

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids, in duplicate, for **Conway Road Resurfacing Project, Mason Road to Interstate 270 Overpass**, will be received by the City of Creve Coeur located in the Creve Coeur Government Center, 300 N. New Ballas Road, Creve Coeur, MO 63141, until **2:00 PM CST, TUESDAY, JANUARY 31, 2012**, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Late Bids will not be accepted and will be returned to the sender, unopened.

Project Manuals will be available beginning **Tuesday, January 3, 2012**, for pickup from the Creve Coeur Government Center, at the location and address stated above. No fee will be charged to view or obtain one (1) copy of the Project Manual. A pre-bid meeting will be held on **Wednesday, January 18, 2012**, at the Creve Coeur Government Center, beginning promptly at **2:00 PM CST**. All bidders are encouraged to attend this meeting.

The scope of work includes the milling and re-surfacing of approximately 1.75 miles of Conway Road from Mason Road to approximately 140 feet east of the Interstate 270 Overpass. Construction includes, but is not limited to: asphalt milling, localized pavement repairs, intersection grading, installation of a new asphalt driving surface, sidewalk improvements to create an ADA-compliant accessible route, curb replacement, manhole and inlet repairs, installation of solar powered crosswalk signals, and installation of a rain garden. Work shall be in accordance with these Specifications and Job Special Provisions. Where not specifically covered by these Specifications or Job Special Provisions, the contractor shall adhere to the 2011 Edition of the "St. Louis County Standard Specifications for Highways Construction," by the St. Louis County Department of Highways and Traffic. In the event that an item is not covered by the previous specifications, the most current edition of the 2011 Edition of the "Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction" by the Missouri Department of Transportation, will govern.

The scope of work for this project requires a **Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 20%** to perform this federal-aid work.

The successful Bidder shall be required to comply with the most current applicable Federal (Davis Bacon Act) and State statutory provisions concerning the payment of prevailing wages on public works, Sections 290.210 through 290.340 R.S. Mo. 1959, as amended.

A bid security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid amount must accompany each Bid in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

A Bid may not be modified, withdrawn or cancelled by the Bidder within sixty (60) days following the time and date designated for the receipt of Bids, and each Bidder so agrees in submitting his Bid.

The City of Creve Coeur hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.
