

# NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed Bids will be received by the City Manager's Office of the City of Hazelwood, 415 Elm Grove Lane, Hazelwood, Missouri 63042, until 10:00 a.m., (prevailing central time) on **November 29, 2011** and will thereafter be publicly opened and read aloud in the City Council Chambers.

The proposed work includes the furnishing of materials, tools, equipment and labor necessary to **reconstruct Missouri Bottom Road between Taussig and Tulip Tree** in Hazelwood, Missouri. Work includes the construction of:

**Approximately 1,168 feet of two lane asphalt or concrete pavement, including demolition, removals, clearing and grubbing, grading, storm sewers, concrete curbs and gutters, concrete entrance, concrete sidewalks, BMP facilities, MSD 5 rock blanket, guard rails, paved ditches, modular block retaining walls, and other appurtenances.**

- (a) Plans and specifications may be obtained on and after **November 8, 2011** for a **\$150** non-returnable fee at EDM Incorporated, 220 Mansion House Center, St. Louis, Missouri. Make all checks payable to "**EDM Incorporated.**"

Each bid must be accompanied by a cashier's check or certified check, or a Bid Bond executed by the BIDDER and an approved surety company and payable to the **City of Hazelwood**, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the sum total of the base bid.

Not less than the higher prevailing hourly rates of wages as found by State or Federal Wage Rates, or determined by court on appeal, shall be paid to all workers performing work under this Contract.

All requests for clarifications on these bidding documents must be received in writing at least one week prior to the bid opening.

The Prime Contractor must be on MoDOT's approved contractor listing. This requirement includes that the Contractor has submitted to MoDOT a fully responsive Contractor Questionnaire and/or Contractor Prequalification Questionnaire with attachments no later than seven (7) days prior to the date and hour of the bid opening (see Section 102.2 of the "Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011" for more details). The Prime Contractor must perform, with its own organization, work amounting to not less than 30% of the total original contract price.

A Performance Bond and Payment and Materials Bond are required.

The CITY, with MoDOT approval, reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive informalities therein to determine the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder and best bid, and to approve the bond. No Bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to the specified time for receipt of Bids.

The CITY intends to issue the Notice to Proceed on or about **February 1, 2012**.

The City of Hazelwood hereby notifies all BIDDERS that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises (DBE) will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award. **A DBE goal of 20%** has been established for this project. Only the work performed by DBE subcontractors that appear on MoDOT's approved listing at the time of bid opening will be applied towards calculating the DBE goal.
