Due to the nature of work, the certification of authority with the Missouri Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Professional Land Surveyors and Landscape Architects is waived for this project. If you have additional questions regarding MoDOT's pre-qualified list, please contact the project manager listed in the RFQ.

DBE firms must be certified by the Missouri Department of Transportation in order to be counted as participation towards an established DBE Goal. We encourage DBE firms to submit as prime consultants for any projects they feel can be managed by their firm. We also encourage both DBE firms and non-DBE firms to consider joining MoDOT's Mentor/Protégé program whenever possible as part of a MoDOT project.

MoDOT will evaluate firms based on: Experience, Qualifications of Personnel Assigned, Project Plan, recommendations from references and overall clarity and quality of qualifications. We request all responses be received by 3:00 pm, January 6, 2017 at the appropriate office.
