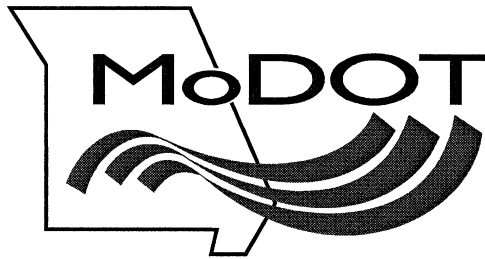

Dear Consultant:

The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission is requesting the services of a consulting engineering firm to perform the described professional services for the project included on the attached list.

If your firm would like to be considered for these consulting services, you may express your interest by responding to the appropriate office, which is indicated on the attachments. Limit your letter of interest to no more than two pages. This letter should include a statement to indicate why your firm is interested in the project(s). It should also include any other information which might help us in the selection process, such as the persons or team you would assign to each project, the backgrounds of those individuals, and other projects your company has recently completed or are now active. We will utilize the consultant information already on file so we will not need a lengthy submittal of other general company information.

DBE firms must be certified by the Missouri Department of Transportation in order to be counted as participation towards an established DBE Goal. We encourage DBE firms to submit letters of interest as prime consultants for any projects they feel can be managed by their firm.

We request all letters be received by 4:00 pm, September 12, 2005 at the appropriate office.

***As of September 1, 2005, requests for professional services will no longer be sent through the U.S. Mail.*** They will be posted on MoDOT's web site and an e-mail will be sent to you when a new solicitation has been posted. Follow the instructions below to the web page where the solicitations are posted:

1. Enter "www.modot.gov" into a web browser
2. Click on "Business" in the left pane
  - a. The menu that appears when you click on "Business" does not include a link to the page containing the solicitations. Please ignore the menu and move your cursor on to the page that appears when you click on "Business".
3. Scroll half way down the page and click on "General Information for Design Consultants"

<b>Boone County, Route WW</b>	
<b>Job No:</b>	J5S0766
<b>Location:</b>	North Fork of Grindstone Creek
<b>Proposed Improvement:</b>	Bridge Replacement & Roadway Capacity Improvements
<b>Length:</b>	1.0
<b>Approximate Construction Cost:</b>	\$3,000,000
<b>Consultant Services Required:</b>	Surveying, conceptual study, preliminary design, right of way plans, and final design plans for the proposed improvement. Bridge design to be done by MoDOT.
<b>Other Comments:</b>	<p>The consultant will provide any necessary information for MoDOT staff to obtain environmental and cultural clearances. Mapping has been produced for this project.</p> <p>Design of this project will be combined with J5P0891</p>

<b>Job No:</b>	J5P0891
<b>Location:</b>	Route WW interchange in Columbia
<b>Proposed Improvement:</b>	Capacity Improvements
<b>Length:</b>	0.1 mile
<b>Approximate Construction Cost:</b>	\$500,000
<b>Consultant Services Required:</b>	Surveying, mapping, conceptual study, preliminary design, right of way plans, and final design plans for the proposed improvement
<b>Other Comments:</b>	<p>It will be necessary for the consultant to obtain mapping for the project.</p> <p>The consultant will provide any necessary information for MoDOT staff to obtain environmental and cultural clearances.</p> <p>Design of this project will be combined with J5S0766</p>

<b>Consultant Services Required:</b>	Surveying, conceptual study, preliminary design, public hearing (if public meeting otherwise), right of way plans, and final design plans.

<b>Location:</b>	Route D, 0.7 mile south of Route JJ.
<b>Proposed Improvement:</b>	Replace existing bridge over Salem Creek. Includes grading, drainage, paving and bridges.

<b>Approximate Construction Cost:</b>	\$0.4 Million
<b>Consultant Services Required:</b>	Preliminary design (roadway only), right of way plans, and final design plans for the proposed improvement.
<b>Other Comments:</b>	The consultant will prepare preliminary roadway plans. The consultant will prepare right of way plans and final design plans (roadway) for the proposed improvements. Preliminary and final bridge design will not be included in this solicitation. This project has been given a categorical exclusion.

<b>Location:</b>	Route 67, Route 34 in Wayne County to Madison County line(JOP0929). Wayne County line to end of four lane at Fredericktown(JOP0928).
<b>Proposed Improvement:</b>	Add a lane to provide part divided, part undivided four lane facility in the location listed above. Includes grading, drainage, paving and bridges.
<b>Length:</b>	10.45 miles(JOP0929), 16.70 miles(JOP0928)
<b>Approximate Construction Cost:</b>	\$41.7 Million(JOP0929), \$42.8 Million(JOP0928)
<b>Consultant Services Required:</b>	Surveying services to provide the following data: Digital map model of all project area features, digital terrain model, bridge surveys for structures for JOP0929. Bridge surveys for structures will be the only surveying services required for JOP0928.
<b>Other Comments:</b>	The consultant will be required to provide this survey data on an expedited schedule. The project schedule calls for all data to be collected and provided to MoDOT six months after a notice to proceed is ordered. Both horizontal and vertical control points have been established for the entire corridor. MoDOT will provide coordinates to the selected consultant. The survey data provided by the consultant will be based on this corridor control system. All survey data will be provided in geopak and microstation formats.

<b>Location:</b>	Route 67, 1.6 miles south of Route F to Route 34 in Wayne County(JOP0931). Route O in Butler County to 1.6 miles south of Route F in Wayne County(JOP0930).
<b>Proposed Improvement:</b>	Add a lane to provide part divided, part undivided four lane facility in the location listed above. Includes grading, drainage, paving and bridges.
<b>Length:</b>	12.95 miles(JOP0931), 8.0 miles(JOP0930).
<b>Approximate Construction Cost:</b>	\$43.1 Million(JOP0931), \$26.8 Million(JOP0930).
<b>Consultant Services Required:</b>	Surveying services to provide the following data: Digital map model of all project area features, digital terrain model, bridge surveys for structures for JOP0931. Bridge surveys for structures will be the only surveying services required for JOP0930.
<b>Other Comments:</b>	<p>The consultant will be required to provide this survey data on an expedited schedule. The project schedule calls for all data to be collected and provided to MoDOT six months after a notice to proceed is ordered.</p> <p>Both horizontal and vertical control points have been established for the entire corridor. MoDOT will provide coordinates to the selected consultant. The survey data provided by the consultant will be based on this corridor control system.</p> <p>All survey data will be provided in geopak and microstation formats.</p>

Cape Girardeau County, Route I-55	
<b>Job No:</b>	J0I0767A
<b>Location:</b>	2.4 miles north of Route 61/34 interchange with Route I-55.
<b>Proposed Improvement:</b>	Construct outer roads between East Main Street and Route 61/34 interchange. Includes grading, drainage, paving and bridges.
<b>Length:</b>	2.40 mile
<b>Approximate Construction Cost:</b>	\$9 Million
<b>Consultant Services Required:</b>	Mapping, conceptual design, bridge surveys and roadway preliminary design.
<b>Other Comments:</b>	The consultant will provide the services listed above. Project development beyond preliminary design and detailed bridge design will not part of this contract.

## 9. District 10

Cape Girardeau County, Route I-55	
<b>Job No:</b>	J0I0767
<b>Location:</b>	2.4 miles north of Route 61/34 interchange with Route I-55.
<b>Proposed Improvement:</b>	Construct new interchange and connection to East Main Street in Jackson, Missouri. Includes grading, drainage, paving and bridges.
<b>Length:</b>	0.75 mile
<b>Approximate Construction Cost:</b>	\$6 Million
<b>Consultant Services Required:</b>	Final roadway design plans, quantities, estimate and job special provisions to prepare contract documents for a Summer 2006 letting.
<b>Other Comments:</b>	<p>The consultant will prepare final roadway plans.</p> <p>MoDOT has developed this project to right of way plan stage. The selected consultant will use these right of way plans as the basis for final plans preparation.</p> <p>MoDOT will remain the lead organization in regards to preparation of bridge plans.</p>
