The Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission requests the services of consulting engineering/environmental firms to perform professional services as described below, specifically relating to environmental cleanup of lead-impacted soil. Firms interested in these services must have the resources and personnel to be able to comply with tight deadlines and specific requirements. If a firm cannot commit to these requirements, based on the services described below, please do not respond to this letter.

Project Description: The project is located in Madison, St. Francois, and Ste. Genevieve Counties in an area north of Fredericktown, Missouri. The site is identified as the "Highway OO Lead Site" (Site). The Site and work required is under the authority of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, 42 U.S.C. §§ 9604, 9606(a), 9607,and 9622, as amended. Past mining and mine waste disposal and/or use practices have impacted areas. The Site consists of lead-impacted soil piles.

Scope of Work: The consultant will provide professional, technical, and other personnel, equipment, materials and all other things necessary to complete the work, which includes site characterization and prompt removal of lead-impacted soil, if required. As directed by EPA, the work will include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Work Plan
- Quality Assurance Project Plan
- Field Sampling Plan
- Health & Safety Plan (shall meet or exceed requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration and be prepared in accordance with 29 CFR 1910, i.e. 40-hour HAZWOPER certification required).
- Monthly Progress Reports
- Site Characterization will include extensive soil sampling.
- Removal of lead-impacted soil to an approved location.
- Post Removal Site Control Plan
- Removal Action Report

Limit your letter of interest to no more than two pages. Letters of interest should include a statement to indicate why your firm is qualified to provide the services outlined above. It should also include any other information which might help us in the selection process, such as the persons or team you will assign, the backgrounds and qualifications/certifications of those persons, their office locations and projects your company has recently completed, or are now active. We will utilize the consultant information already on file so a lengthy submittal of other general company information is not necessary.
