Location:	Front Street Interchange
<b>Proposed Improvement:</b>	Revisions to the interchange beginning in 2007
Length:	NA
Approximate Budget Cost:	\$200,000
Consultant Services Required:	Identification and implementation of transportation demand management (TDM) strategies.
Other Comments:	The proposed construction will cause significant disruptions in the traffic flow through an area that already experiences significant delays during peak hours.  Industrial sites, a truck stop, retail and commercial
	spaces populate this area. Consequently, there are a large number of transport trucks moving through this interchange, in addition to automobiles.
	As a part of this project, MoDOT needs a consultant to identify and implement TDM strategies to mitigate the disruption to traffic before and during construction.
	Once a set of strategies has been identified, the consultant will create informational materials for use throughout the corridor. The consultant will also develop educational material for the new interchange configuration.

Other Comments:	Consultant will develop the purpose and determine the root causes of the need for a west corridor around Joplin.  Final product will be in the form of a written report thoroughly documenting the existing and future needs of the corridor.  This study will be developed in accordance with all applicable federal regulations and guidelines.  This study shall satisfy the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requirements for this element of study.
