EXHIBIT I

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The work covered by this Agreement shall include furnishing equipment, materials, professional, technical, and personnel resources necessary for the performance of researching, investigating and monument corners, marking property lines and completion of a sealed plat for parcel(s).

The SURVEYOR shall commence work within ten (10) days after he has received written approval from the Department Representative and will complete the work by February 19, 2010.

The following information will explain and define the items of importance relating to this project. All the elements of work that are necessary to satisfactorily complete the surveying of this project may not be listed. The lack of a specific listing of an element or item of work does not in itself constitute a basis for additional services or work supplement, and/or adjustment in compensation.

I. PROJECT

Consultant shall be responsible for all research of:

- title records and abstracts (may include deeds of record, title certification, etc.).
- evidence from recorded surveys.
- highway plans and right of way deeds in the affected area.
- deeds and plats for affected properties.

The survey shall be referenced to Missouri Coordinate System of 1983. First or Second Order control networks will be conducted as prescribed in Missouri Minimum Standards 10 CSR 30-4.

Consultant shall produce a survey report containing the following:

- List of personnel involved and their duties during survey.
- Detail of findings and what was used to determine boundary location and existing right of way lines.
- Signature and seal of responsible surveyor.

Consultant shall update or create corner documents as per Missouri Minimum Standards for Property Boundary Surveys 10 CSR 30-3.

Consultant shall provide the department with a preliminary survey plat for review of new MoDOT boundary lines before monuments are to be set.



Consultant shall provide the department with survey plats as per Missouri Minimum Standards for Property Boundary Surveys 10 CSR 30-2 and meet all requirements set forth by county recorder of county where the parcel is surveyed. Plat will show all encroachments either of record or physical. A checklist for review of survey plats (as provided) will be completed and submitted with each survey plat.

Consultant shall set monumentation along MoDOT's new boundary line as per MoDOT's EPG and all others to meet the permanent monument description as defined by Missouri Minimum Standards for Property Boundary Surveys 10 CSR 30-2.060.

Consultant shall record the survey plat with the county recorders office.

IV. Beginning the Work.

- a. The consultant shall start work provided that MoDOT has notified the consultant that work may begin.
- b. No work shall be done without MoDOT notification that work may begin.
- c. The procedures indicated in the specifications will be followed.

V. Acceptance of Completed Work

- a. The consultant shall submit all completed work promptly to allow time for proper review. Work reviewed and found in accordance with the specifications shall be recorded with the county recorder's office. The work is considered to constitute "satisfactorily completed and accepted work" following notification of the filing book and page as provided by the county recorder is sent to the realty to roads project director.
- b. In the event that some work is found to be unacceptable in accordance with the specifications, and reworking is deemed necessary, the consultant agrees that it shall redo such work without expense to the Missouri Department of Transportation, even though final payment may have been received. The consultant must give immediate attention to these changes so there will be a minimum delay. The above and foregoing is not to be construed as a limitation of the Missouri Department of Transportation right to seek recovery of damages for negligence on the part of the consultant.
- c. Return of Source Data: The consultant shall return to the Commission all of the provided source data, including all aerial photographs and maps.
- d. Data Quality. The consultant shall be responsible for the professional quality, technical accuracy and the coordination of data, documents and other services furnished for this project.
 - i. Additional Services. The Commission reserves the right to request additional work beyond the scope of services



addressed in this document. In this event, a supplemental agreement shall be executed and approved prior to the performance of additional services. Changes in compensation will be addressed in the supplemental agreement.

- ii. Documentation. The consultant shall provide any documentation necessary to explain, support and clarify the procedures used for data development.
- iii. Data Ownership. All data and documents prepared in performance of this Scope of Services shall be delivered to and become the property of the Commission upon suspension, abandonment, cancellation, termination, or completion of the consultant's services.

VI) Schedule and Delivery

- a. <u>Schedule</u> The consultant will continuously prosecute the work and survey deliverables shall be submitted MoDOT as they are completed. The time of completion for all of the work addressed in these documents shall be <u>February 19, 2010</u>.
- b. The Commission will grant time extensions for unavoidable delays beyond the control of the consultant. Requests for extensions of time shall be in writing by the consultant, before plans are due, stating fully the reasons for the request.
