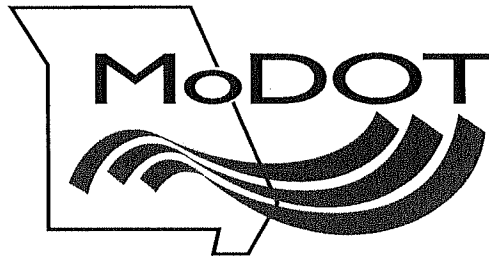

Dear Consultant:

The Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) and the Kansas City Southern Railway Company (KCSR) are requesting the services of a consulting engineering firm to perform the described professional services for the project included on the attached list. If your firm would like to be considered for these consulting services, you may express your interest by responding to the MoDOT, District Four, District office. Limit your letter of interest to no more than two pages. This letter should include any information which might help us in the selection process, such as the persons or team you would assign to the project, the backgrounds of those individuals, and other projects your company has recently completed or are now active.

We encourage DBE firms to submit letters of interest as prime consultants for any project they feel can be managed by their firm. DBE firms must be listed in the MRCC DBE Directory located on MoDOT's website at [www.modot.gov](http://www.modot.gov), in order to be counted as participation towards an established DBE Goal.

MoDOT and KCSR will evaluate firms based on a) experience and competence, b) the capacity of the firm to perform the work in the timeframe needed, c) past performance, and d) proximity to and familiarity with the project area.

It is required that your firm's Statement of Qualification and an Affidavit of Compliance with the federal work authorization program along with a copy of your firm's E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding be submitted with your firm's Letter of Interest.

We request all letters be received by 4 pm, July 30, 2010 at 600 NE Colbern Road, Lee's Summit, Missouri 64086

Proposed Improvement:	Construct a half diamond interchange at relocated Thunderbird Road.
Length:	.25 miles
Approximate Construction Cost:	\$5.0 million
Consultant Services Required:	<p>Roadway Design Services to include: preliminary plans, and final plans. ROW plans are not anticipated. Also include any design services during construction.</p> <p>Bridge Design Services to include: Bridge Surveys, layouts, memorandums, preliminary plans and final plans. Possibly some geotechnical work. MoDOT will provide available data from previous projects in the area.</p> <p>Construction Management and Construction Inspection Services to include: Managing and Inspection of the contractors work, approval of contractor's invoices for payment to the contractor by KCSR, reviewing change orders, concurring with MoDOT and KCSR. Preparation of final plans for MoDOT.</p>
Other Comments:	Excellent project management skills are essential. PM must adhere to budget and schedule. There will be a two week only negotiation with the selected consultant. PS&E on the project is due January 10, 2011 for a March 2011 letting. The contractors notice to proceed will be mid April 2011.
