Job No.:	J4I2023B
Location:	Immediately west and adjacent to Bartle Hall in Kansas City
Proposed Improvement:	Replacement of existing Broadway Street Bridge (Bridge No. A1117) over Route I-670. New bridge will have 55'-0" roadway and two 10' sidewalks. Aesthetic enhancements will be included.
Length:	The existing 5 span continuous concrete box girder bridge has a total length of about 366 feet. Roadway improvements will be needed beyond the bridge ends.
Approximate Construction Cost:	\$5,000,000 - \$7,000,000
Consultant Services Required:	Bridge: Determine a cost efficient structure and foundation type that can accommodate expedited construction to meet the project deadlines. The consultant shall produce the preliminary and final bridge design. Shop drawing checking and load rating will be performed by MoDOT.
	Surveying: MoDOT will set survey controls. All other necessary surveying for the project will be provided by the consultant.
	Geotechnical: All geotechnical work (both field work and laboratory) will be provided by the consultant.
	Roadway: The consultant will produce preliminary and final roadway plans. Construction will be restricted to existing right of way.
Other Comments:	The consultant will be expected to coordinate closely with MoDOT personnel. Construction of the project must be completed and all lanes open to traffic by September 16, 2011 for the opening of the Performing Arts Center.
	An April 22,2011 letting is expected.
	PSE due date will be February 14, 2011
	No interviews or presentations. Due to short timeframe it is anticipated that consultant selection will be made within one week of the due date for letters of interest. Goal is to have the project under contract with a consultant quickly.
