

RFQ for Potential Site Development

The Lewis County Port Authority is seeking qualified engineering / consulting firms for developing a conceptual site plan for a potential development site.

The design services needed to be performed include but are not limited to the following

- Roadways for Site Access & Internal Circulation
- Riverfront & In-River Infrastructure
- Rail Spur Track and / or Loop Track
- Dry Bulk Material Handling Equipment & Storage
- Liquid Bulk Material Handling Equipment & Storage
- Roll On / Roll Off Ramp
- Container Storage Area
- Over Dimension / Over Weight Storage Area
- Utility Connections to Area (Sewer, Water, Electric, Nat Gas)
- Barge Fleeting Area(s)

Interested parties must have, and will be scored based on: Prior marine engineering experience; Work history; Familiarity with Upper Mississippi River; Demonstrated ability to work within Federal and MoDot funding requirements and deadlines. Each segment will be scored on a 1-25 point basis.
