





Comparing AM December 2018/January/February 2019 vs December 2019/January/February 2020

NB I-55 AM Overall Mobility DECREASED for the AM peak from 2018-2019 → 2019-2020. Mobility decreased during the 6am and 7am hours, but the 8am hour saw a slight +1.2% increase in mobility.










INCREASE in Overall PM Mobility

I-55

Comparing PM December 2018/January/February 2019 vs December/January/February 2020

NB I-55 PM Overall Mobility INCREASED from 2018-2019 → 2019-2020, except during the 1pm and 2pm hours which saw a -1.9% and -1.2% decrease in mobility.

SB I-55 PM Overall Mobility INCREASED throughout the PM peak from 2018-2019 \rightarrow 2019-2020 with the largest increase occurring during the 6pm hour (+6.6% increase in mobility).





- Location: St. Louis County Westbound I-270 past Northbound I-170
- Event Type: Police Investigation for shooting resulting in a two-vehicle crash and a secondary crash
- Estimated Initial Impact: Non-Rush Hour: 4 of 4 travel lanes affected equals (=) 100%
- Incident Details: TMC personnel overheard emergency units being dispatched to a crash on Westbound I-270 west of I-170 while actively monitoring scanner traffic. A driver of a passenger vehicle was shot. The vehicle was hit numerous times causing the driver to lose control and collide with a tractor trailer. The driver was pronounced at the scene. All westbound lanes of the interstate were closed while the Major Case Squad investigated the homicide.
- Action Taken: The TMC confirmed the location via CCTV, entered the event into ATMS and immediately activated appropriate DMS boards. This also auto generated the closure into TMS to alert drivers. Hazelwood Police, Fire & EMS responded, as did the MSHP and the St. Louis County Police. St. Louis County took command of the scene. MoDOT Emergency Responders were dispatched to assist with traffic, which was diverted onto Southbound I-170 and North Hanley for drivers to use the outer roads. Traffic engineers monitored traffic signals for signal timing adjustments. The SL City County IM Text and CO Incident alerts were sent out. Communications Staff, Motor Carriers, and the Incident Management Coordinator were all notified. At 11:42 a.m., TMC Operators observed a secondary accident in the queued traffic on Westbound I-270 west of New Florissant Road. A small passenger car rear ended a tractor trailer that had slowed in the traffic. At approximately an hour into the incident, Berkeley Police shut down Northbound I-170 at Airport Road at the request of Hazelwood Police. Drivers could use Northbound Hanley Road to get back to Eastbound I-270 or use the North Outer Road to go west. Traffic queued 2.5 miles on Westbound I-270 and a mile on Northbound I-170.

The maintenance unit arrived responded and treated roadway. The traffic queue was minimal due to time of day.

Signal engineers began adjusting signals at Winghaven for the detour. ER was dispatched when they came into service and brought oil dry to the scene because of fluid leaks from the vehicles. The Medical Examiner arrived along with a reconstruction team. A call report for Guard Cable damage was created and sent to MT contracts.
