INVITATION TO BID ROAD AND BRIDGE WORK

Bids are due on September 25, 2020 at 2:00 PM (Central Standard Time). It is preferred that bids be submitted electronically via www.PublicPurchase.com OR Sealed proposals shall be delivered prior to the return date and time to:

Bids shall be endorsed "Proposal" for constructing North Home Ave. Bridge 14100071, Clay County. Bids will be received by Clay County until 2:00 P.M. (Central Standard Time) on Friday, September 25, 2020 (9/25/2020). Bids will NOT be accepted after this date and time under any circumstances. Due to Co-Vid 19 Protocols there will be no in-person public opening of Bids. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud via Zoom Meeting with a date and time to be established in a forthcoming Addendum.

The proposed work includes:

Bridge Demolition, Grading, Constructing a 40' Precast Prestressed Box Beam Span, and a 24'-0" roadway with an Optional 10" HMA or 8" JPCP surface, on the above road where it crosses over Branch to Fishing River approximately 4.1 miles North of Liberty, Missouri including all incidental work in accordance with the plans and specifications.

The wage rates applicable to this project have been predetermined as required by law and are set forth in the bid proposal. When Federal wage rates are applicable and included, this contract is subject to the "Work Hours Act of 1962," (P.L. 87-581; 76 Stat. 357) and implementing regulations. The contractor must pay the higher of State vs. Federal wage rates.

Clay County Highway Department hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that on any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, business owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

Note: All prime contractors must be on MoDOT's Approved Contractor Listing 7 days prior to bid opening. DBE Sub-Contractors must be on the MRCC DBE Directory prior to Bidding.

The Prime Contractor must have a fully responsive contractor questionnaire on file with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC) at least seven (7) days prior to the bid opening date.

Missouri Law, 292.675 RSMO, requires the awarded contractor and its subcontractors (S) to provide a ten-hour occupational safety and health administration (OSHA) construction safety program (or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations as a qualified substitute) for their on-site employees (laborers, workmen, drivers, equipment operators, and craftsmen) who have not previously completed such a program and are directly engaged in actual construction of the improvement (or working at a nearby or adjacent facility used for construction of the improvement). The awarded contractor and its subcontractor (s) shall require all such employees to complete this ten-hour program, pursuant to 292.675 RSMO, unless they hold documentation on their prior completion of said program. Penalties for non-compliance include contractor forfeiture to Clay County in the amount of \$2,500, plus \$100 per contractor and subcontractor employee for each calendar day such employee is employed beyond the elapsed time period for required program completion under 292.675 RSMO.

SALES TAX:

This is a sales tax exempt project. The County will provide contractor with a tax exempt certificate which may be used in purchasing materials to be used on this project. This exemption applies to all tangible personal property materials which will be incorporated into or consumed during the course of the work. It does not apply to the purchase of construction machinery, equipment or tools.

PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BONDS:

The successful bidder will furnish a performance and payment bond in accordance with 37.12 of the Clay County, MO Code of Ordinances, in the amount of 110% of the contract amount that is issued by a surety licensed to do business in the state of Missouri with a A.M. Best rating of at least A.

PREVAILING WAGES:

This is a prevailing wages project. The contractor (and all subcontractors) must comply with Missouri's prevailing wages law and must pay not less than the prevailing wage hourly rate of wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed, as determined by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations and in accordance with the applicable Wage Order.

BUY AMERICAN AND DOMESTIC PRODUCTS:

It is the policy of the Clay County, Missouri, to buy materials, products, supplies, provisions, and other articles produced, manufactured, compounded, made or grown within the State of Missouri, when they are found in marketable quantities in the state, and are of a quality suited to the purpose intended and can be secured without additional cost over products of other states; provided however, that quality and fitness of articles shall be considered in purchasing or letting contracts for articles herein mentioned. It is also the policy of the Clay County, Missouri to buy goods or commodities that have been manufactured, assembled, or produced in the United States of America.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST AND DEBARMENT:

By submission of its bid, the bidder certifies that:

- A. No Elected Official, nor any County Administrator, any Assistant County Administrator, or the County Purchasing Agent is financially interested in what the bidder is offering to sell or perform for the County pursuant to this invitation, nor is the bidder a County employee or board member whose bid creates a conflict of interest. A conflict of interest would arise if a County employee or board member were in a position to affect either the decision to solicit bids or the selection of the successful bidder;
- B. Bidder has not participated in collusion or committed any act in restraint of trade, directly or indirectly, which bears upon anyone's response or lack of response to this Invitation; and
- C. The Bidder and each of its principals are not suspended or debarred by Clay County, Missouri, the State of Missouri, the Federal government, or any other local, state, or federal agency.

EVALUATION:

The County may consider the following factors in determining / evaluating a bid:

- A. The ability, capacity, and skill of the bidder to perform the agreement or provide the required services, materials, equipment or supplies;
- B. Whether the bidder can perform the agreement or provide the materials, equipment or supplies promptly or within the time specified, without delay or interference;
- C. The quality of performance in previous agreements;
- D. The previous and current compliance by the bidder with laws and ordinances related to the agreement or service;
- E. The sufficiency of the bidder's financial resources to perform the agreement or provide the commodities; and
- F. The ability of the bidder to provide future maintenance or warranty service.

Award will be made to the lowest most responsible responsive bidder who submits the bid most advantageous to the County and will best serve its interests. The County reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities and technicalities, to request re-bids, and to determine the firm submits the lowest and best bid in the County's judgment. Each bidder is solely responsible for all costs and expenses in preparing its bid, participating in the bidding process, submitting any information to the County, responding to any request for additional information, or participating in interviews, if requested. The submission of a bid in response to this Invitation to Bid constitutes an agreement of the bidder to these conditions.

A bid that satisfies the Clay County's criteria and is deemed acceptable by the County Administration does not constitute a contract or bind Clay County in any way.

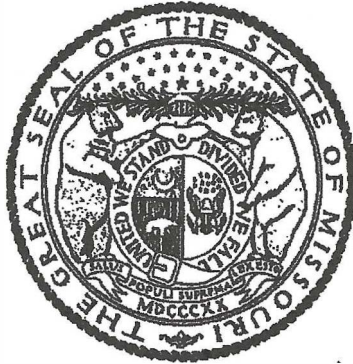

OVERTIME and HOLIDAYS

OVERTIME

For all work performed on a Sunday or a holiday, not less than twice (2x) the prevailing hourly rate of wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed or the public works contracting minimum wage, whichever is applicable, shall be paid to all workers employed by or on behalf of any public body engaged in the construction of public works, exclusive of maintenance work.

For all overtime work performed, not less than one and one-half (1½) the prevailing hourly rate of wages for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed or the public works contracting minimum wage, whichever is applicable, shall be paid to all workers employed by or on behalf of any public body engaged in the construction of public works, exclusive of maintenance work or contractual obligation. For purposes of this subdivision, "**overtime work**" shall include work that exceeds ten hours in one day and work in excess of forty hours in one calendar week; and

A thirty-minute lunch period on each calendar day shall be allowed for each worker on a public works project, provided that such time shall not be considered as time worked.

January First;
The last Monday in May;
July Fourth;
The first Monday in September;
November Eleventh;
The fourth Thursday in November; and
December Twenty-Fifth;

If any holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be considered a holiday.
