## **Project Facts:**

- This project is part of Governor Parson's statewide bridge rehabilitation emphasis
- Rehabilitation of eastbound and westbound bridges over Perche Creek in Boone County
- Existing bridge decks: eastbound (A0095) 39' width; 716' in length; westbound (G0519) 40' width; 698' length
- Proposed improvement consists of structural repairs and painting
- ♦ Project will be let in required combination with the westbound Auxvasse Creek Bridge Rehabilitation Project in Callaway County on I-70
- ♦ The I-70 eastbound on-ramp from Midway/Route UU will be closed during eastbound bridge rehabilitation
  - Midway/Route UU will detour to the Routes O/J interchange to access eastbound I-70

## **Bridge Facts:**

- ◆ Constructed in 1958 (eastbound) and 1940 (westbound)
- Rehabilitation is necessary to maintain the condition of the bridges
- ♦ These bridges carry approximately 23,000 vehicles per day per direction with 24 percent trucks

## **Traffic Impacts:**

- ♦ Interstate will be open during construction
- Lane drops and temporary barrier wall will be in place during construction
- Only one bridge will be under construction at a time
- ♦ Construction is expected to take 5 months with a December 1, 2021 completion date
