To all interested parties:

The Southwest District of the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) is preparing to advertise for bids for a bridge replacement on Route 86 over Tablerock Lake at the Taney/ Stone County line near Ridgedale, Missouri (Job Number J7S3194), locally known as the Long Creek Bridge. The existing bridge was built in 1956. This project will construct a new bridge south of the existing structure, including a short section of new roadway connecting it to existing Route 86.

Contractors will be allowed the opportunity to include in their bid proposal, pricing for a pre-approved Alternate Technical Concept (ATC) that differs from the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) base design proposal. ATCs allow for innovation and cost savings to obtain the best value for the project that meets or exceeds the project goals, and which provides a product equal to or better than the concept it replaces. The ATC guidelines and procedures for this project are restricted to concepts, design standards, specifications, materials, products, construction methods and design solutions for intermediate bridge bents, including bents 5 through 9.

The Commission furnished proposal documents contain all of the proposed work for the project to be bid. If an ATC(s) is pre-approved by the Commission, the contractor will have the option of submitting a bid for the pre-approved ATC(s) or for the Commission furnished proposal. The contractor will only be allowed to submit one bid for the project.

A virtual informational meeting is scheduled from 1:00 to 2:00 p.m. on Monday, January 11, 2021. The meeting will consist of presentations on the project history, location and schedule, including a detailed description of the ATC process, submittal and review procedures, constraints and expectations. The meeting will conclude with a brief question and answer period.

Those interested in engaging in the ATC process will submit a request for access to the secure project SharePoint site. On Tuesday, January 12, 2021 the following will be posted to the SharePoint site: list of attendees from industry meeting, as-built plans, right-of-way plans, design criteria, alignment study, bridge memo, preliminary bridge plans, preliminary geotech information, design exceptions, and RER/completed CE.
