It is required that your firm's Statement of Qualification (RSMo 8.285 through 8.291) be submitted with your firm's Letter of Interest, or be on file with the Missouri Department of Transportation. The statement of qualification is not included in the total page count limit.

DBE firms must be listed in the MRCC DBE Directory located on MoDOT's website at [www.modot.gov](http://www.modot.gov), in order to be counted as participation towards an established DBE Goal. We encourage DBE firms to submit letters of interest as prime consultants for any project they feel can be managed by their firm.

It is required that your firm be prequalified with MoDOT and listed in [MoDOT's Approved Consultant Prequalification List](#), or your firm will be considered non-responsive.

We request all letters be received by 5:00 PM, (03/19/2021) at Lincoln County Highway Department, Attention: Eric Tapley, 219 Hwy H, Troy, MO 63379.

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**RFQ Scope of Services**

**Roadway**

The engineering responsibilities may include but are not limited to the following:

The preparation of Conceptual plans, Preliminary plans, Contract plans and Right of Way Plans. Design services may include, right of way plans, surveying, geotechnical investigations, public involvement, environmental and historic preservation services/permits, contract documents, assisting with the bidding process, construction support/construction inspection, utility coordination/permits and traffic controls including the preparation of PS&E and final documents.

**Construction Inspection**

Construction Phase: work with contractor on behalf of the County, assist with preconstruction conference, perform periodic site inspection, prepare change orders, inspect construction materials, check shop drawings submitted by contractor, conduct construction test and inspection, be present during critical construction operations, work with County to do full time inspections and reporting and participate in final inspection.
