

BID NOTICE

Sealed bids for SECKMAN ROAD INTERSECTION & PEDESTRAIN IMPROVEMENTS STP-7202(602) & STP-5403(686) will be received at the office of The Department of the County Clerk, Jefferson County Administration Center, 729 Maple Street, Hillsboro, Missouri until 2:00 o'clock P.M. (DST) on, Tuesday April 6th, 2021 at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in triplicate in an opaque sealed envelope, marked with the Project title, name and address of the Bidder, and accompanied by the other required documents. Bids submitted electronically will be rejected. Late Bids will not be accepted and will be returned to the sender, unopened.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on Wednesday, March 24th, 2021 at 10:00 AM, to address questions and concerns regarding the bid specification and bid documents and view the site, if needed. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is strongly encouraged but not mandatory. A zoom meeting invitation will be sent out to the bidders who have sent in the "Plan Holder Contact Information" form listed on page 5 of the specification book.

The proposed work includes: The project limits are from Bellrievue Ln (off Lions Den Road) to 120' east of the Eastern-most entrance of Seckman High School off Seckman Road. The construction work, in general, will consist of 2 new intersection signals, one at the Seckman High School entrance, the other signal at the Seckman Middle/Elementary School Entrance with Pedestrian Push Button actuators, new concrete ADA sidewalks, curb ramps, new closed drainage features, a new round about at the intersection of Old Lemay Ferry Road and Seckman/Lions Den Road with pedestrian crossings, LED Street scape lighting, new concrete pavement and asphalt pavement, along with new pavement striping. The total two project length is - Phase 1 - 2,752' Phase 2-1,288' - Combined 4,040'.

Work shall be in accordance with the provided Specifications, Job Special Provisions, and Plans. Where not specifically covered by the Specifications, or Job Special Provisions or Plans, the Contractor shall adhere to the currently effective 2020 Edition of the "Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction", and the currently effective "MoDOT Standard Plans for Highway Construction." The contractor shall have a maximum of One Hundred Forty Five (145) Working days to complete the Phase 1 and 2 projects.

Plans and specifications for this project will be available, at no cost, downloadable files from the Jefferson County website (<https://www.jeffcomo.org/Bids.aspx?CatID=18>), beginning Friday, March 12th, 2021.

The bidder will be responsible to check the County's website for addendum(s) regarding this project prior to bid opening. All potential bidders must complete the "Plan Holder Contact Information" form and submit this form to Public Works at pwprojects@jeffcomo.org and request placement on the bidder's list.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work, of a similar character in this locality, as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate) or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

Jefferson County, Missouri hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2020 Edition. **The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.**

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on any public works project must provide a minimum 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal. A certificate of insurance shall be submitted with each proposal.

All bids shall be made on the forms provided. To be eligible to be awarded the project you must submit bids for both Seckman Road Intersection & Pedestrian Improvement projects Phase 1 STP-7202(602) and Phase 2 STP-5403(686).

Three (3) copies of the bid must be submitted, one (1) being original inked.

Jefferson County, Missouri reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality in the bids received, and to award the contract to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder, with MoDOT concurrence.

The DBE goal for this project is: Phase 1: STP-7202(602) -15%, and Phase 2: STP-5403(686) - 11%

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
