E251 (61 of 62) – The sign details were updated to reflect the different installation types. The sheet has been reissued and is attached with this addendum.

Justification: The existing signs are old and will not be able to be extended. New signs will be installed instead.

E252 (62 of 62) – The sign notes were updated to reflect the different installation types. The sheet has been reissued and is attached with this addendum.

Justification: The existing signs are old and will not be able to be extended. New signs will be installed instead.

3. **QUESTIONS**

What are the size of the Hold Position Markings?

Answer: Hold Position Markings are to be thermoplastic and are sized per FAA AC 150/5340-1M.

What is the width of Pavement Edge Markings

Answer: 3-feet wide. Please note Pavement edge markings will not be removed for temporary displaced threshold

Are beads required in temporary markings?

Answer: Beads are not required in the temporary markings

How will you ensure potential bidders are familiar with the site?

Answer: The contract documents require potential bidders to be familiar with the site. Each bidder is responsible for ensuring they are familiar with the project site.

For full panel repair, is the base course and subgrade required to be replaced?

Answer: The intent of the design to use the existing base course and subgrade currently in place. Additional work may be needed on a case by case basis, including minor grading and recompacting the base.

What is the restriction of the amount of new concrete that could be diamond ground?

JVIATION[®]

Answer: Per P-501-4.19(f) diamond grinding shall not exceed ¹/₂-inch. The total area is not limited, so long as the depth does not exceed ¹/₂-inch and the equipment does not damage the individual panels.

For P-101b is the quantity Square Yards or Square Feet? It shows both units in the document.

Answer: P-101b spall repair should be per square feet. Please see the attached updates where this is corrected.

Can we use our standard bid bond form from our bonding company?

Answer: We recommend utilizing the bid bond form provided in the contract documents to ensure all the information needed is correct.

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185 <u>Contract Time</u>. The owner has established a contract perform time of 110 Calendar Day(s) from the date of 186 the Notice-to-Proceed. All project work shall be substantially completed within the stated timeframe. This 187 project is subject to liquidated damages as prescribed in the project manual.

189 Bid Security. No bid will be considered unless accompanied by a certified check or cashier's check on any 190 bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, payable to the Owner, for not 191 less than five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid, or by a bid bond secured by an approved surety or 192 sureties, payable to the City of Kirksville, for not less than five (5) percent of the total amount of the bid.
