

Road Work

Invitation to Bid

The proposed work includes: Approximately 530 linear feet of Route 9 between 5th Street and just north of 7th Street. Improvements include pavement mill & overlay, full depth pavement widening for turn lanes, sidewalk & trail, street lighting, and storm sewer.

This project is located in Parkville, Missouri and will be built under the Missouri Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2020. If MoDOT Specifications do not apply, Overland Park Design and Construction Standards, 2017 shall be used.

Sealed bids for Six at Park Intersection Improvements will be received at: 8880 Clark Avenue Parkville, MO 64152 until 10:00 o'clock A.M. on April 15th, 2021 at said time and place. Promptly thereafter, all bids will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in a sealed opaque envelope.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Parkville, MO hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award."

All bidders must be on MoDOT's Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2011 Edition including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier's check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Parkville, MO reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 10%.

No 2nd tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

The Contract shall be awarded in one Contract to the lowest, responsive, responsible, approved bidder.
