- Be at least 18 years of age for most trades.
- Have a high school diploma or a GED.
- Have an official high school or college transcript
- Be a resident of the respective union's jurisdictional area.
- Have a valid driver's license.
- Be able to meet the physical demands of the trade.
- Be able to read, write and speak the English language
- Pass drug testing.

- Have a Birth Certificate.
- Be a U.S. citizen or Resident alien.
- Military DD-214 Form for Veterans
- Recommendation letters, if requested.
