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City of Gary – Gary Sanitary District Gary Resident Referral Program For Construction & Building Trades



History

On January 21, 1998, the City of Gary and the Common Council signed into law the City of Gary Business Promotion Ordinance (GBPO), Ordinance No. 6972. This ordinance among other things called for a minimum work force of two-thirds City of Gary qualified Gary residents. The said 2/3 is to be equally distributed among the various job classifications-i.e. laborers, carpenters, electricians and professional services- used by the contractors on city-funded projects. Subsequently, on February 9, 1999 the Gary Sanitary District's Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 2113, which mirrored the City's Ordinance.

Purpose

The purpose of the Gary Resident Referral Program is to refer Gary residents to contractors required to meet the 66 ^{2/3} % residency requirement and to provide a conduit through which contractors and residents can connect for the purposes of increasing employment opportunities on City of Gary and Gary Sanitary District construction projects.

Objectives

- Increase number of Gary residents referred to work on construction projects
- Increase number of Gary residents working on construction projects
- Increase awareness of career opportunities in the construction industry

Strategies

The goals of the Gary Resident Referral Program will be accomplished through the implementation of the following actions.

- Hold Annual Gary Resident Referral Program Outreach Conference at the Genesis Center
- Resident required to complete Gary Resident Registration Form
- Referral will also be made available online
- Residents will be categorized by level of experience and interest in the various trades
- A database of residents will be maintained and updated consistently. A list will be made available and distributed to contractors and other vendors seeking local residents.
- Quarterly or monthly status reports will be provided to Deputy Mayor's office.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Gary Resident Referral Program (GRRP)?

The Gary Resident Referral Program is a supplement to the City of Gary's Ordinance No. 6972 and the Gary Sanitary District's Resolution No. 2113. It was created to help contractors meet the 66.67% residency requirement, introduce local residents to the various building and construction trades by referring them directly to the union apprenticeship coordinators, and assist local residents that are already members of the union with identifying employment opportunities.

How does it work?

The residents of Gary are the foundation of the Gary Resident Referral Program. Residents are asked to complete and submit the Resident Registration Form. Information from that form is then entered into our database. Residents are referred to contractors and apprenticeship programs based on their trade affiliation or interest. It's that simple. The Compliance Office will follow up with the contractor and the apprentice coordinators to track the status of each referral. Only the resident's name, address, phone number(s), and trade affiliation or interest will be shared. All other information will remain confidential.

Does this program replace the City of Gary Ordinance No. 6972 or the Gary Sanitary District Resolution No. 2113?

No. The program is designed to strengthen the local regulations by providing a means through which to enforce and ensure compliance.

How does this program benefit the contractor?

Through the program, contractors will be able to contact residents directly for employment on construction projects.

How will the union apprenticeship programs be impacted by the GRRP?

One of the goals of the program is to refer interested local residents to the various trade apprenticeship programs including the Indiana Plan. Booklets compiled by the School to Career/Union Construction Industry of Northwest Indiana will be disseminated and made available to persons who are considering a career in the construction industry.

Can non-union Gary residents participate?

Yes. The program is open to all residents of Gary regardless of race, color, religion, sex, marital status, age, national origin, disability, or veteran's status. Non-union residents will be provided with a booklet of all union apprenticeship programs that outlines the requirements of the program and application period.

If I am already a member of a union, how will this program help me?

As a union craftsman, you will be referred directly to contractors seeking your skill.

I've registered for the program, now what?

Once your registration form is received and your information is verified, the Gary Compliance Office will enter your information into the database. As projects arise, your contact information will be forwarded to contractors looking to utilize your trade on a construction project. You will receive periodic communication from the Compliance Officer to check on your status. You do not need to contact the Compliance Office. We will contact you if you are referred. This is not an employment program; there is no Out of Work List.

Am I guaranteed employment by registering for the GRRP?

No. We do not guarantee employment or acceptance to any apprenticeship program.
