

Chestnut Expressway Rebuild Between I-44 and Broadview Place, Springfield



PROJECT FACTS

- Replace the concrete pavement on Chestnut Expressway between I-44 and Broadview Place/ Haseltine Road (Farm Road 115) in Springfield
- Install new guardrail and road signs
- Project will take approximately 2 months
- Estimated total project cost: \$2.2 million

PROJECT TIMELINE

- June 2021 Project awarded to construction contractor Emery Sapp and Sons. Inc. of Columbia
- Spring 2022 Construction begins
- June 2022 Project complete



- Phase 1 (four weeks to complete)
 - Chestnut Expressway traffic shifts to the westbound lanes with two through lanes -- one in each direction
 - I-44 eastbound off-ramp (mile marker 72) closed for one weekend
 - Haseltine Road (Farm Road 115) at Chestnut Expressway closed for one weekend
- Phase 2 (three weeks to complete)
 - Chestnut Expressway traffic shifts to the eastbound lanes with two through lanes -- one in each direction
 - I-44 eastbound on-ramp (mile marker 72) closed for one weekend
 - Broadview Place at Chestnut Expressway closed for one weekend
