Notice to Contractors**

Sealed bids for **the Hanley Road Reconstruction and Improvements STP-5613(608), City Project No. 970811**, will be received at the Dardenne Prairie City Hall, 2032 Hanley Road, Dardenne Prairie, Missouri, until 9:00 o'clock A.M. (Prevailing Local Time) on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May 2021, at the office of the City Clerk, and at that time will be publicly opened and read. All bids shall be submitted in the form of proposal, provided in the specifications and delivered in a sealed envelope clearly marked on the outside **“Sealed Bid No. 970811-01”** to the City Clerk’s Office on or before the time specified above. No facsimiles will be accepted.

The proposed work includes grading, paving, drainage, signal, and retaining wall improvements between Feise Road and Pleasant Meadow Drive, a distance of about 2,300 linear feet, more or less.

All labor used in the construction of this public improvement shall be paid a wage no less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages of work of a similar character in this locality as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (Federal Wage Rate), or state wage rate, whichever is higher.

The City of Dardenne Prairie, Missouri, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, businesses owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, religion, creed, sex, age, ancestry, or national origin in consideration for an award.”

All bidders must be on MoDOT’s Qualified Contractor List per Section 102.2 from the current version of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, including all revisions. The contractor questionnaire must be on file 7 days prior to bid opening.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works project provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

A certified or cashier’s check or a bid bond in the amount of 5% shall be submitted with each proposal.

The City of Dardenne Prairie, Missouri reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The DBE Goal for this project is 10%.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> tier subcontracting will be allowed on this project.
