Sealed proposals for the construction of the **24**<sup>th</sup> **Street Sidewalk Project**, Federal Project # TAP-3905(404), for the <u>City of Lexington</u>, will be received by the OWNER until <u>2:00 P.M.</u> on <u>Thursday, June 3, 2021</u> at the <u>Lexington City Hall, 919 Franklin Avenue, Lexington, MO 64067</u> where at that place and time said proposals shall be publicly opened and read aloud. The proposed work includes: Sidewalk Improvements along 24<sup>th</sup> Street from Aull Lane heading North approximately 1520' LF and terminating just before reaching the future walking trial on the abandoned railbed. The proposed project will also include some curb and gutter repair, a stormwater box, and an addition of a handrail to an existing stormwater concrete box.

The Proposal shall be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check drawn on a solvent Missouri bank or trust company made payable to the City of Lexington, or a Bid Bond issued by a surety licensed to conduct business in the state of Missouri and appearing on the U.S. Treasury Department's most current list (Circular 570, as amended), in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid. The Bid Bond may be retained by the City of Lexington, as a guaranty that if the Proposal is accepted, the bidder will execute the Contract and file an acceptable Performance Bond and Payment Bond within fifteen (15) days after the award of the Contract.

The Contractor doing the work must pay for labor at rates not less than those certified pursuant to Section 290.210-.340, RSMo. (1986) by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations as indicated by the schedule included in the Contract Documents.

The award of Contracts on this project shall be predicated upon competitive bidding, with award being made to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. Said lowest Bidders shall be determined for each Contract by summarizing the applicable low base bids.

Contractors and sub-contractors who sign a contract to work on public works projects must provide a 10-Hour OSHA construction safety program, or similar program approved by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, to be completed by their on-site employees within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the construction project.

The contract DBE goal for the amount of work to be awarded is 10% of the total federal project price.

No 2<sup>nd</sup> Tier Subcontracting will be allowed on this project.

The <u>City of Lexington</u> reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive all informalities in the bids. No bids may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to the specified time for receipt of bids.
