- The Cole Route A Bridge over South Moreau Creek is included in Gov. Mike Parson's \$351 million Focus on Bridges program, which will repair or replace 250 bridges across the state
- Proposed improvement includes removal and replacement of bridge (R0235) over South Moreau Creek
- Bridge is located 8 miles south of Russellville (on Route A)
- Project will be let in required combination with the Moniteau Route A bridge replacement over Enon Creek west of Enon Only one bridge will be under construction at a time

Bridge Facts:

- Constructed in Mid 1960's
- Existing bridge deck: 20' width
- Approximately 246 vehicles use the bridge daily

Proposed New Bridge:

- New bridge will remove current weight restrictions, resulting in two travel lanes across bridge deck
- New bridge deck: 24' width; 262' length

Traffic Impacts:

- Route A will be closed at the bridge during construction
- Construction for bridge (A9037) over South Moreau Creek is expected to take 3 months

Construction:

- Construction starts in 2022
- December 1, 2022 completion date


