## PEDESTRIANS AND NON-MOTORIZED VEHICLES

The Commission recognizes that the transportation system is used by pedestrians and non-motorized vehicles and supports the inclusion of improvements that provide for their safety and accessibility where the need exists. In keeping with Sections 300.405 and 304.024 RSMo 2000, the Code of Federal Regulations, and the Americans with Disabilities Act, the Chief Engineer shall develop policies and procedures for the accommodation of pedestrian and non-motorized vehicles into the planning, design and construction of transportation projects.
