Bridge #A0861 CRD100 over I-44 EB&WB Jasper County

- Joplin Regional Stockyards in NW quadrant
- Heaviest day for Stockyard is Saturdays
- RV businesses on each side of 44
- Steel company has yards on both sides of 44
- WB67 design critical
- Guardrail damaged on every corner
- Better striping at end of the ramps
- Concern with how to tie OR and entrances
- Sight distance at end of ramps crucial
- Already a bit of a sight distance issue at WB ramps seeing NB vehicles



Crash Information 2015-2021

- 5 total crashes
- 3 at EB Ramp 1 angle, 1 driving too
 fast and unable to stop, 1 RE
- 2 at WB Ramp 1 out of control due to driver not stopping at ramp, 1 swung too wide turning right and hit SB vehicle





- Curve on South side




- Farming is the main use








Bridge #S0481 MO97 over Wilder Branch Lawrence County

- 1 crash distracted driver lost control and hit end of structure







- Farm equip. Grain and Milk trucks, fuel and delivery trucks; Seen several trash trucks cutting through this way; I-44 traffic to Ash Grove/Deliveries especially if issues on I44
- Narrow bridge
- County Rd 114 close to the N
- 2 crashes (2015-2021): 1 mirrors colliding when crossing, 1 out of control trying to avoid deer





- Lile Quarry (with multiple contractors) and Rost ready mix cross this bridge multiple times daily.
- Guardrail damage consistent on the WB I-44 on Ramp due to tight radius for semi traffic.
- Also known as Northview bridge, we own gated lot on the NW side (on Evergreen pkwy) of this site if needed for site prep or storage area.
- Outer Roads go to MO125
- Be conscious of sight distance of ramp tie-ins if replaced
- 3 crashes typical of intersection angle and turning

- No known issue of frequent debris removal
- Previous erosion issues on the east end bridge abutment, crews have performed slurry treatment in voids.
- Narrow bridge
- Overhead utilities on N side
- Shallow bedrock
- 2 crashes (2015-2021): 1 rear end when vehicle stopped to allow a large vehicle cross, 1 out of control when trailer started sliding and truck ended up on and hanging over the railing







- Farming/ dump trucks/trash trucks/grain trucks;Local/semi-local trucking transport & deliveries such as live poultry & livestock, milk, feed; regional trucking using Route M as a by-pass between I-44 and US 65, local farmers and equipment
- Undeveloped Conservation land underneath, public river access, boat ramp. No known established encampments.
- Powerline on N side
- Steep slopes
- No crashes

- Low water crossing
- Maybe once per year at the most that we know of and only during extremely heavy localized flash flooding events
- About how deep does the water get when it goes over?
 2'
- How far up the road from the bridge ends does the water reach when water over tops? **50 150'**
- Convenience store food service and fuel trucks, feed trucks, milk trucks, some logging trucks. No established industry other than farming.
- West (north) end of culvert approach is just at the base of a sharp, elevated curve with minimal sight distance for traffic. Driveway entrances immediately adjacent to the culvert.
- R/W tight
- Buggy traffic
- Overhead lines on N side
